

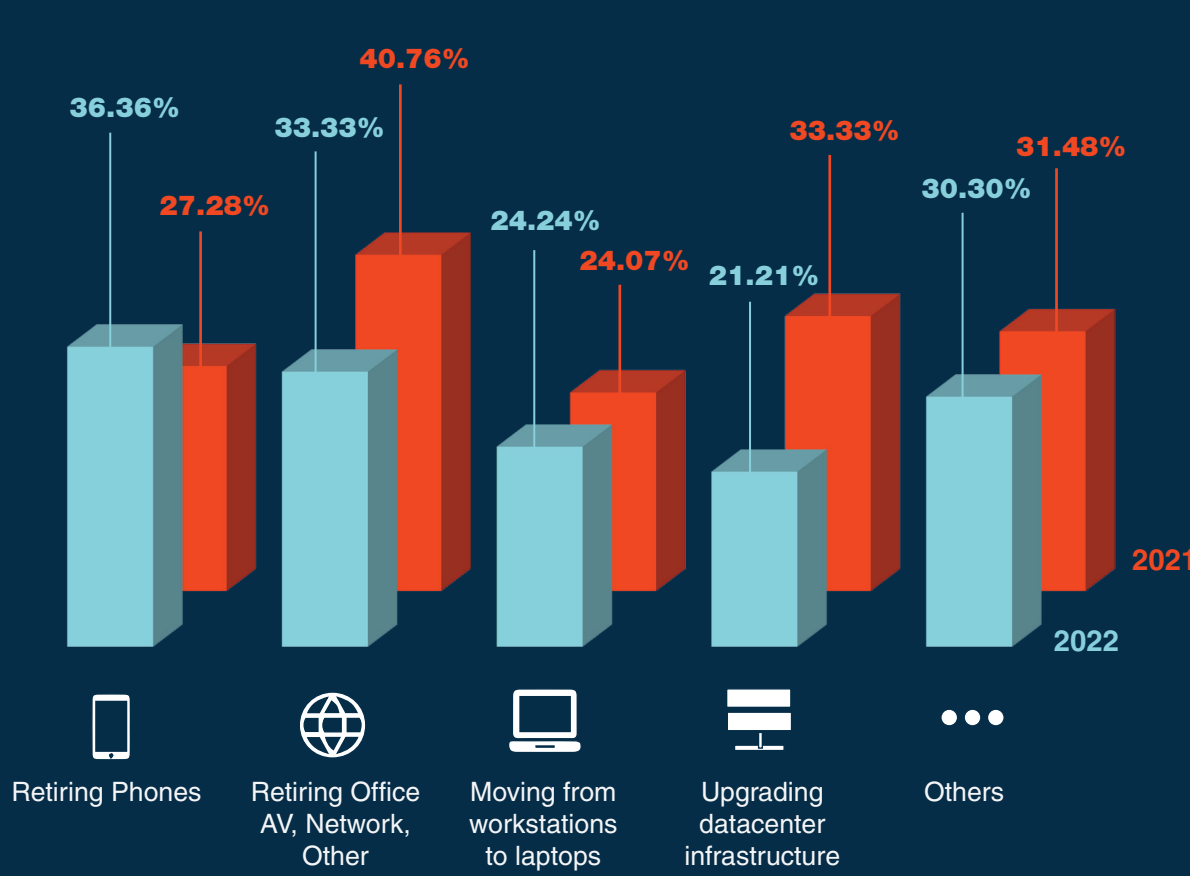

CORPORATE ITAD TRENDS 2022

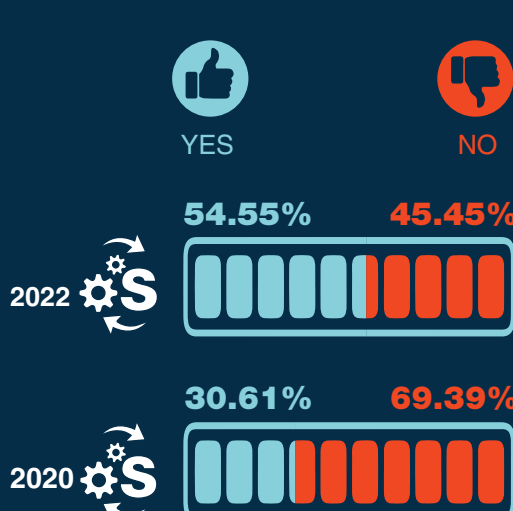

The transition to remote work during the pandemic has driven companies to retire more phone systems.

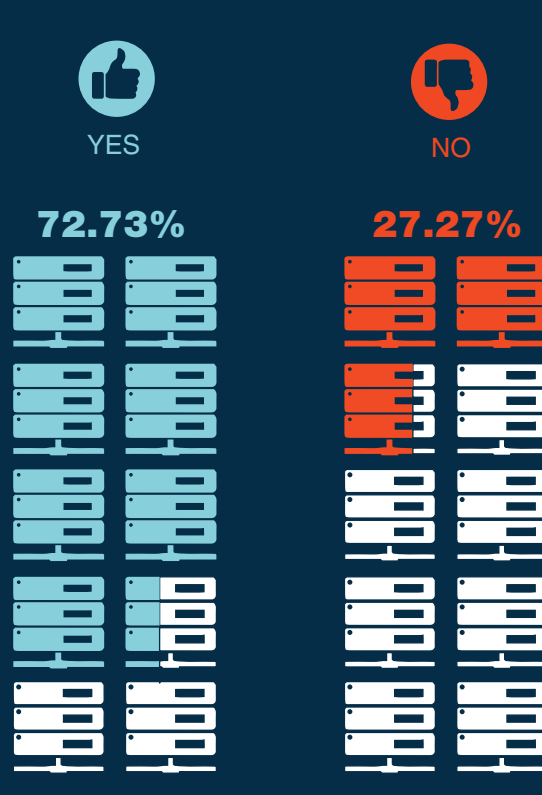
WILL YOU BE UPGRADING YOUR OS?



54%

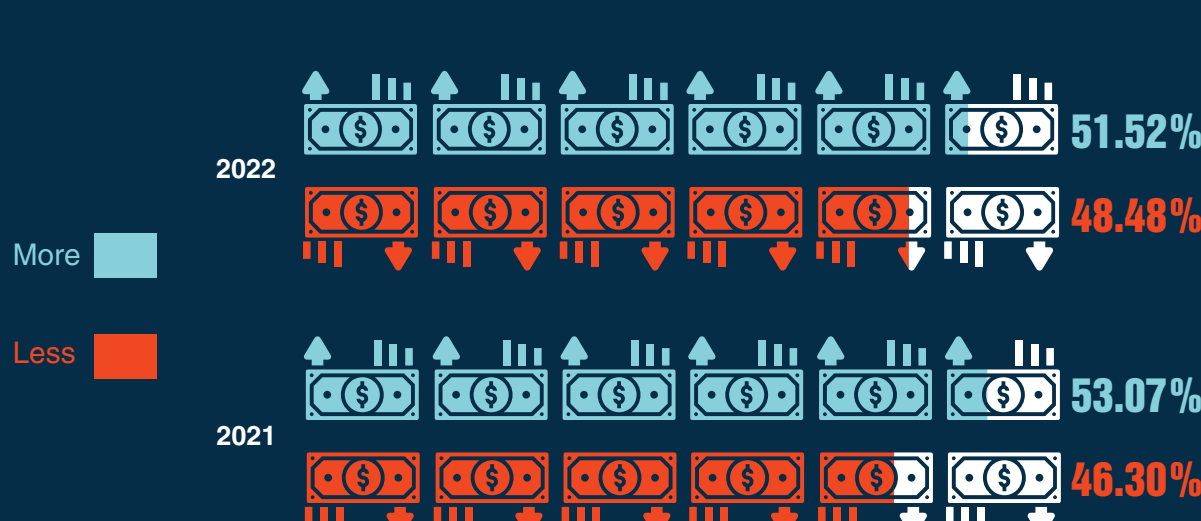
of respondents will upgrade to Windows 11. In 2020 only 30% of respondents were looking to upgrade their OS.

DO YOU STILL HAVE ON-PREMISE DATA CENTERS?



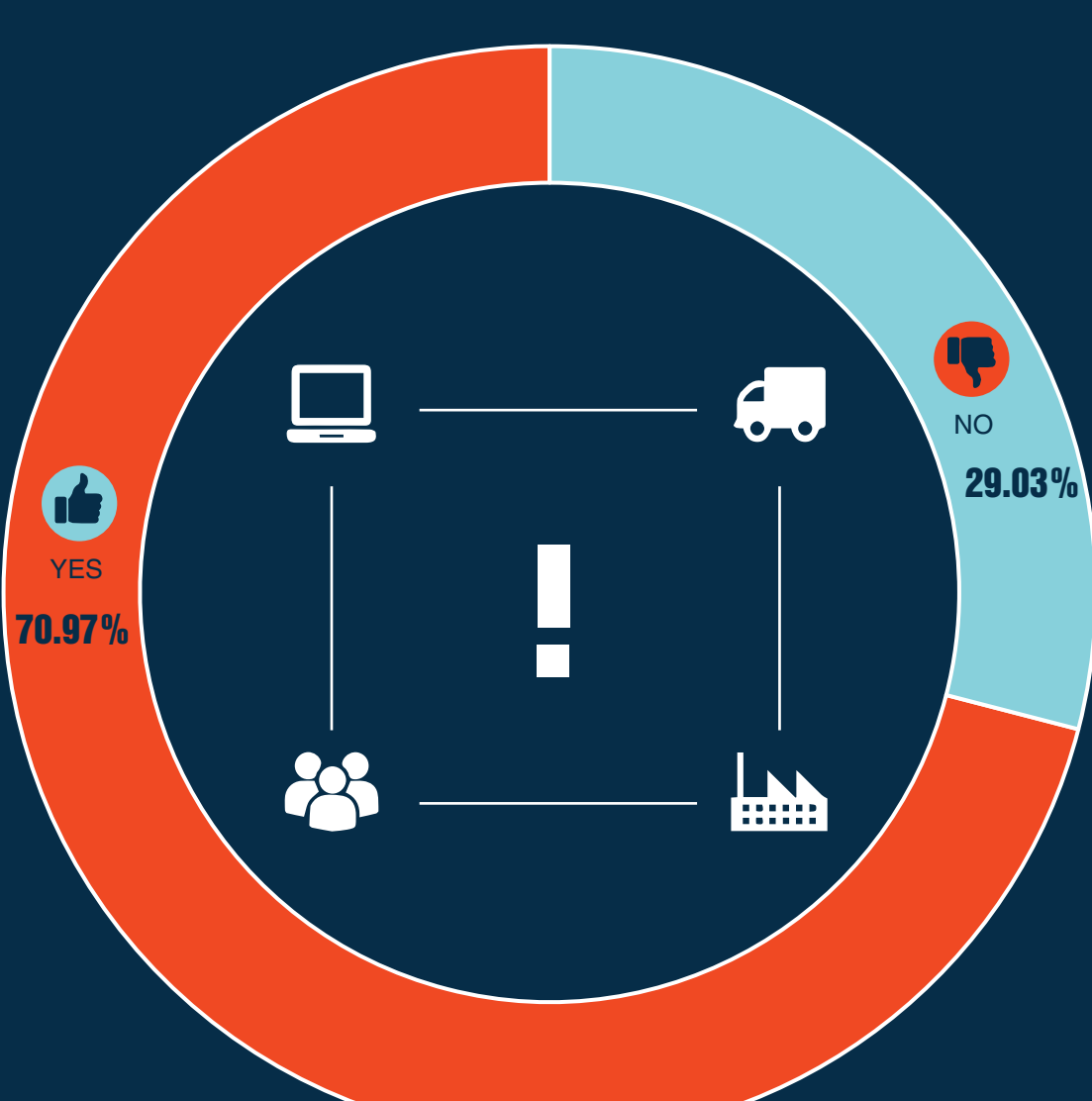
Majority of IT professionals surveyed still have on-premise data centers. Out of those IT professionals 75% plan to keep their data center on-premise.

Enterprises are still planning to spend more this year. 51% of companies plan to spend more in 2022 than in 2021.
